DERBY WITHIN A DERBY (DWD) is a separate entry run on one day, May 1, as a modified division on Starter. Prize list, criteria and entry form are in the DWD tab on the Derby website.

Levels offered: Starter & DWD – 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Dressage Test A, 2' jumps @ 300 mpm
Beginner Novice – 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Dressage Test A, 2'6" jumps @ 325 mpm
Novice – 2018 USEF Novice Dressage Test A, 2'11" jumps @ 350 mpm
Training – 2018 USEF Training Dressage Test A, 3'3" jumps @ 400 mpm
Training/Preliminary – 2018 USEF Preliminary Dressage Test A, 3'3"-3'7" jumps @ 425 mpm

The Derby is a three-phase competition – a dressage test and two jumping rounds. Scores are cumulative. The Dressage phase is ridden in a short arena. The dressage test may be read. The two Jumping phases consist of some cross-country type jumps and some show jumps on a measured and timed track. All jumping tests will run in the grass Jumper Field.

(YOU MAY OPT OUT OF ANY OF THE THREE PHASES OF COMPETITION AND YOU WILL INCUR 300 PENALTY POINTS IN THE FINAL STANDINGS)

Approved helmets, tall boots or paddock boots with half chaps, breeches and a shirt with sleeves must be worn while mounted. Whip length per USEF rules. No formal dress is required. Braiding is not encouraged. Proper saddles and USEF approved bits are required for Dressage.

FRIDAY, APRIL 30

A Dressage Ride-A-Test will be offered in which riders will receive pointers from a USEF judge for a \$25 entry fee. Please note your intent to participate in the Ride-A-Test on your entry blank. Rider times are scheduled. Space may be limited.

Starting at Noon, limited supervised familiarization of the Jumper Field (no fee) will be available until 5:00 pm. This is a grass field and in order to preserve the course, riders' time will be limited and you may only take two or three jumps for familiarization. No lengthy schooling will be allowed.

SATURDAY, MAY 1

All Divisions of Dressage and the first Jumping round will run. The Derby Within-A-Derby Jumping round run and winners will be placed.

SUNDAY, MAY 2

All second Derby Jumping rounds will run. The Derby Move-Up Challenge is optional. Any rider not already signed up for a Move-Up round can sign up for a \$15 fee paid prior to your Move-Up ride. Move-Up rides will be the first to go once the course is set at the higher level, before the regular division starts.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR DERBY COMPETITORS

HORSE VACCINATIONS: All horses entering the property must have a current negative Coggins within the last year. They must also have vaccination documentation for Equine Influenza Virus (EIV) and Rhinopneumonitis (EHV) within the last six (6) months. Documentation may be mailed with entry or presented upon your arrival at the show. Horses without documentation will not be allowed to unload at the show.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL: Covid-19 Protocol and Social Distancing will be in place throughout the competition. All competitors must wear a mask (covering nose and mouth) when unmounted. All volunteers, spectators and staff will be required to wear a mask (covering nose and mouth) unless eating or drinking. Hand sanitizer will be at various locations around the show grounds.
