### IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR DERBY COMPETITORS

**HORSE VACCINATIONS:** All horses entering the property must have a current negative Coggins within the last year. They must also have vaccination documentation for Equine Influenza Virus (EIV) and Rhinopneumonitis (EHV) within the last six (6) months. Documentation may be mailed with entry or presented upon your arrival at the show. Horses without documentation will not be allowed to unload at the show.

**COVID-19 PROTOCOL:** Covid-19 Protocol and Social Distancing will be in place throughout the competition. All competitors must wear a mask (covering nose and mouth) when unmounted. All volunteers, spectators and staff will be required to wear a mask (covering nose and mouth) unless eating or drinking. Hand sanitizer will be at various locations around the show grounds.
