Derby Within a Derby (DWD) is a separate entry run on one day, May 4, as a modified division of Starter. Prize list, criteria and entry blank are on a separate form in DWD file on Derby website

**Levels offered:** Starter & D.W.D. - 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Dressage Test A, 2' jumps @250 mpm  
Beginner Novice - 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Dressage Test A, 2'6" jumps @300 mpm  
Novice - 2018 USEF Novice Dressage Test A, 2"11" jumps @300 mpm  
Training - 2018 USEF Training Dressage Test A. 3'3" jumps @325 mpm  
Training/Preliminary – 2018 USEF Preliminary Dressage Test A, 3'7" jumps @350 mpm

The Derby is a three phase competition – two jumping rounds and a dressage test. Scores are cumulative. The Dressage phase is ridden in a short arena. It may be read. The two jumping phases consist of some cross-country-type jumps and some show jumps on a measured and timed track. All jumping tests will run in the Grand Prix Arena.

*(YOU MAY OPT OUT OF ANY OF THE THREE PHASES OF COMPETITION AND WILL BE ASSESSED 300 PENALTY POINTS IN THE FINAL STANDINGS)*

Helmets, boots, breeches and shirts with sleeves must be worn while mounted. Whip length per USEF rules. No formal dress required. Braiding not encouraged. Saddles and proper snaffle bits required for Dressage.

## **FRIDAY, MAY 3**

Starting at 10 AM, limited supervised schooling and familiarization in the jumping arena (no charge) will be available until 5 pm

A Dressage Ride A Test will be offered in which riders will receive pointers from a USEF judge for a \$25 entry fee. *Please note your intent to participate in the Ride A Test on your entry blank. Space may be limited.*

## **SATURDAY, MAY 4– All Dressage**

ALL DIVISIONS DRESSAGE WILL BE RUN ON THIS DAY plus first Derby jumping round and Derby Within a Derby jumping round.

## **SUNDAY, MAY 5**

Second Derby jumping round and optional Derby Move Up Challenge round for riders wanting to jump one additional round at the next highest offered level. \$15 entry fee.

This will be judged on performance and style. Results will be announced on [www.wayneeventingderby.org](http://www.wayneeventingderby.org) on May 10. The winner will receive a check for \$250.00

All regular Derby entry fees include three nights stabling.

Additional Derby entry, same horse and rider, at consecutive level allowed for \$150

## IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR WAYNE EVENTING DERBY COMPETITORS

Lamplight Equestrian Center has imposed strict regulations for all horses coming onto the facility grounds

**Vaccination documentation certifying that all horses coming onto the grounds will be checked in the show office before that horse can be entered.**

**Documentation must state that the horse has been vaccinated for Equine Influenza Virus (Rhino Pneumonitis) and Equine Herpes Virus (EHV 1) within the past six months (after October 26, 2018).**
